

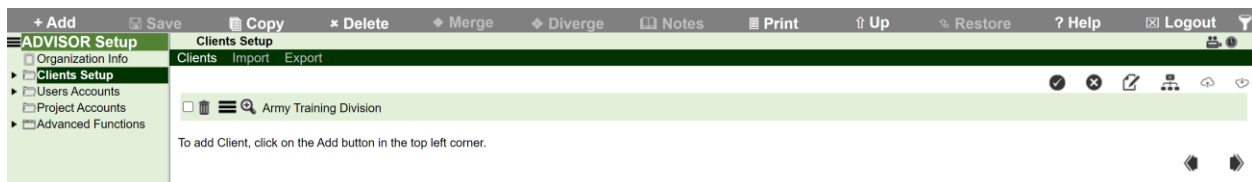

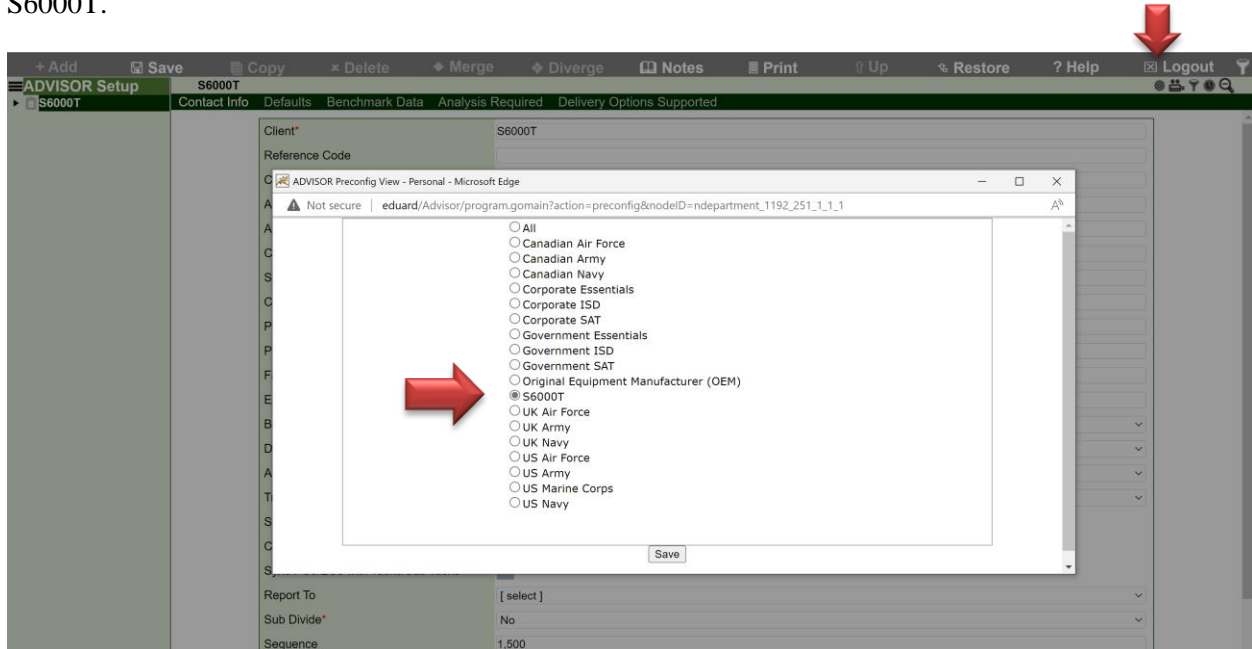
XML Import/Export

To facilitate the exchange of data among users working on separate installations/instances of ADVISOR Enterprise. In other words, allow user within organization A to share analyses with user within organization B. All data associated with a client (i.e., templates, resources, risk analysis, inventory, projects under needs assessment, training analysis, fidelity analysis, project management and performance analysis as well as courses and solutions) can be exported to an XML file. Data can in-turn be imported with a single click.



Support S6000T Standard

S6000T is an international specification for training analysis & design. It is a joint transatlantic development between European and American industrial, aerospace, and defence manufacturers and customers. The goal of S6000T is to establish a global specification for training analysis and design. ADVISOR version 12.90 is S6000T compliant. Moreover, S6000T option is provided in the Client Configuration Wizard to facilitate client setup in-line with S6000T along with an option for aligning ADVISOR’s taxonomy in-line with S6000T.

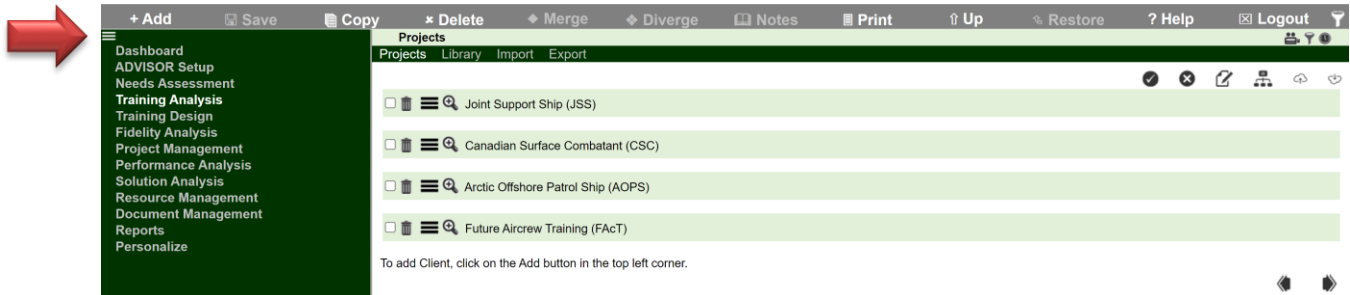


Facilitate Management of Courses with 1,000s of Learning Objectives (LOs)

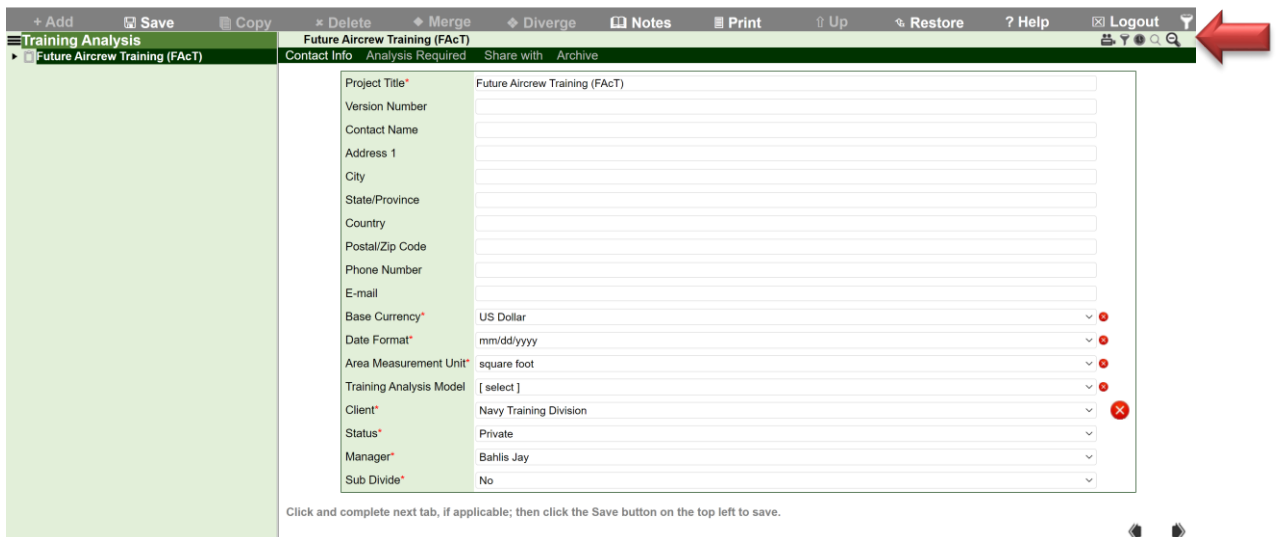
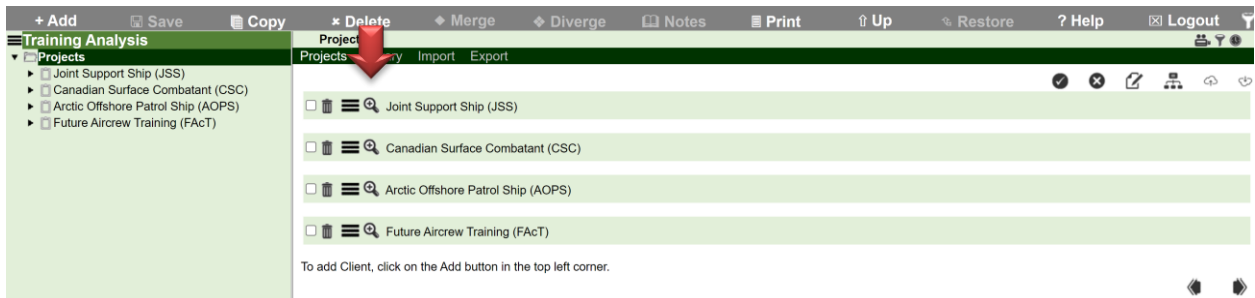
Linking LOs to multiple Performance/Enabling Objectives (POs/EOs) as well as linking LOs to multiple Lessons requires significant memory. As a result, associated functions were limited to courses with ~1,000 LOs. To support courses with 1,000s of LOs, pagination has been introduced to present LOs within multiple pages, and in-turn, reduce memory requirements. Moreover, users can specify number of Rows within each page.

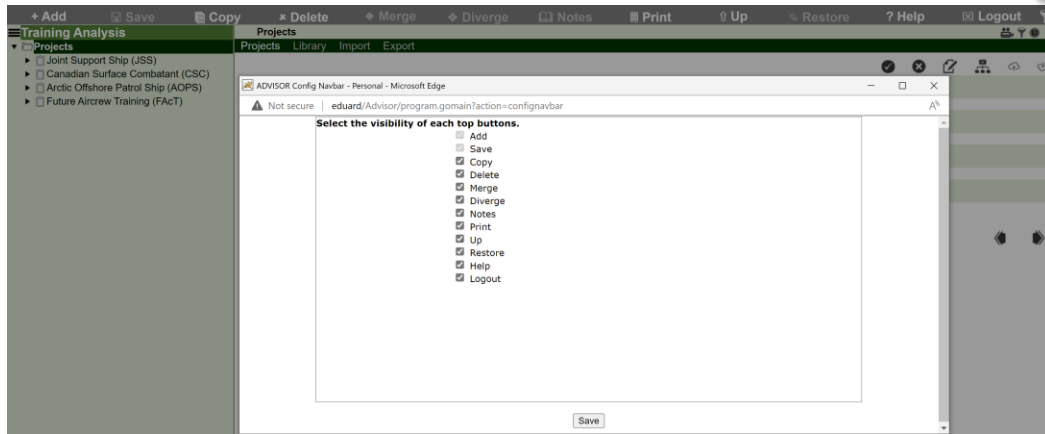
- ❖ Display available modules under Menu icon ☰.



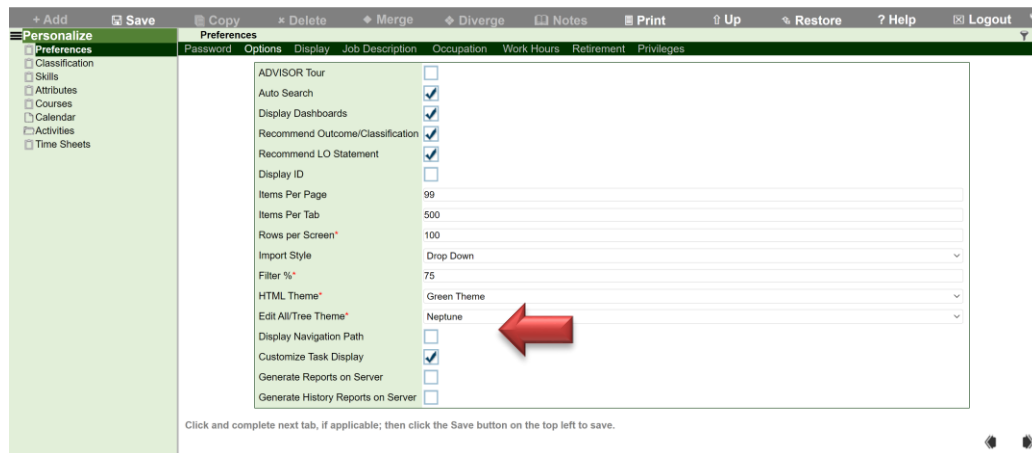
- ❖ Focus on a single project, course, or solution by clicking on the Focus icon 🔍. To redisplay all projects, courses, or solutions, click on the Defocus icon 🔍. Focus will be automatically turned off once you exit ADVISOR.



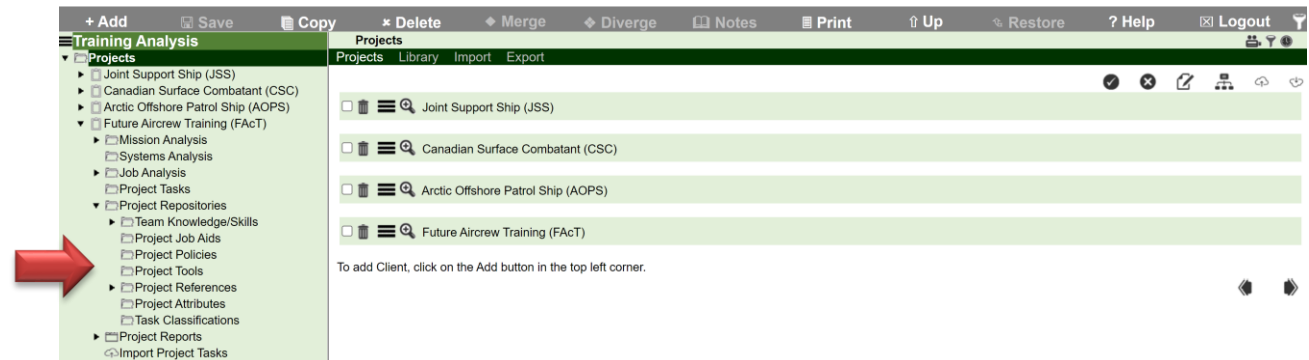
- ❖ Hide action buttons that are rarely used, by clicking on the new filter icon . Select buttons to include/exclude and click save.



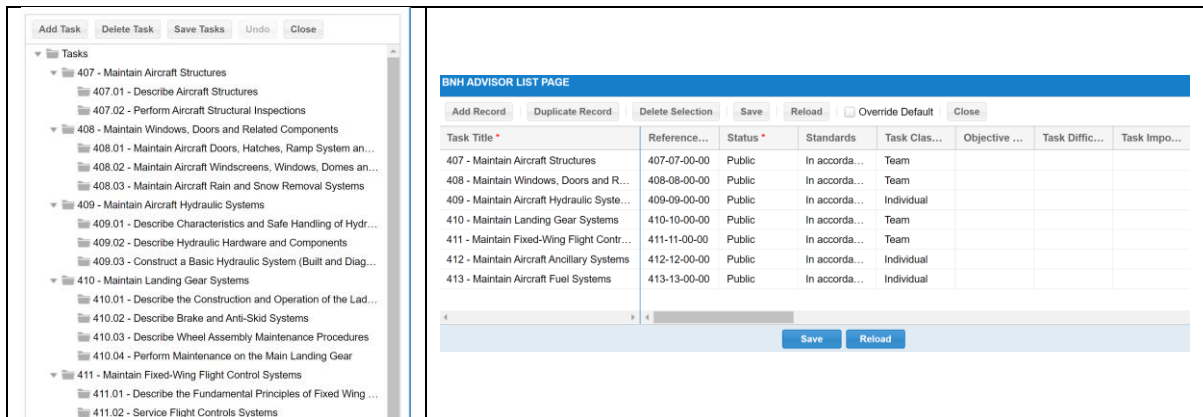
- ❖ Hide or display Navigation Path by placing/removing checkmark next to Display Navigation Path field under Personalize Preferences Options tab.



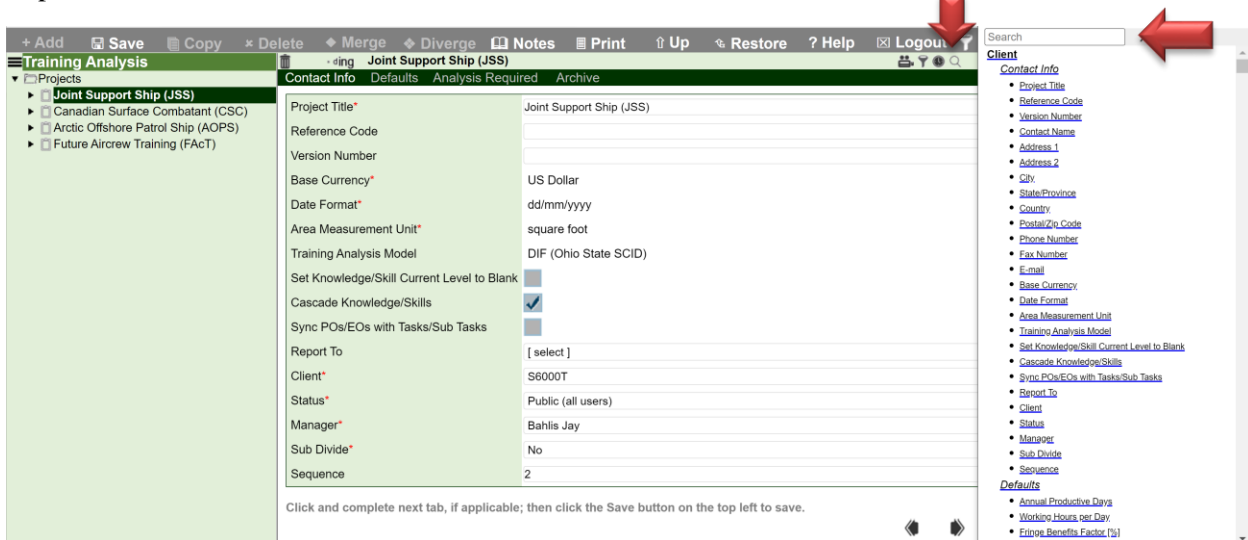
- ❖ Minimize clutter by grouping complementary items under a folder. For example, Team Knowledge/Skills, Project Job Aids, Project Policies, Project Tools, Project Reference, Project References, Project Attributes and Task Classification are placed under Project Repositories folder.



- ❖ Modernize the look and feel of Edit Tree and Edit All. Provide users with 8 themes to choose from.



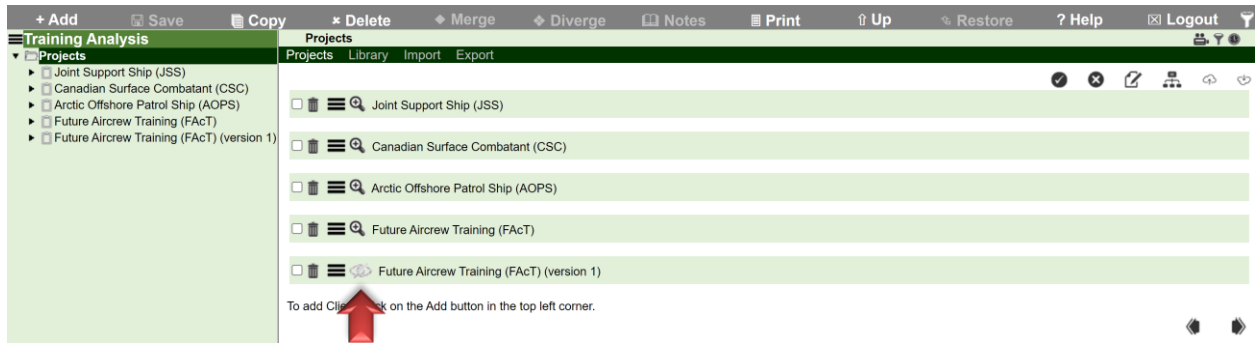
- ❖ Replace Search nodes with icon. Provide a more intuitive Search interface.

- Align taxonomy within reports with selected taxonomy
- Minimize scrolling when cascade button or locks are turned on and off
- Improve the look and feel of result screens.

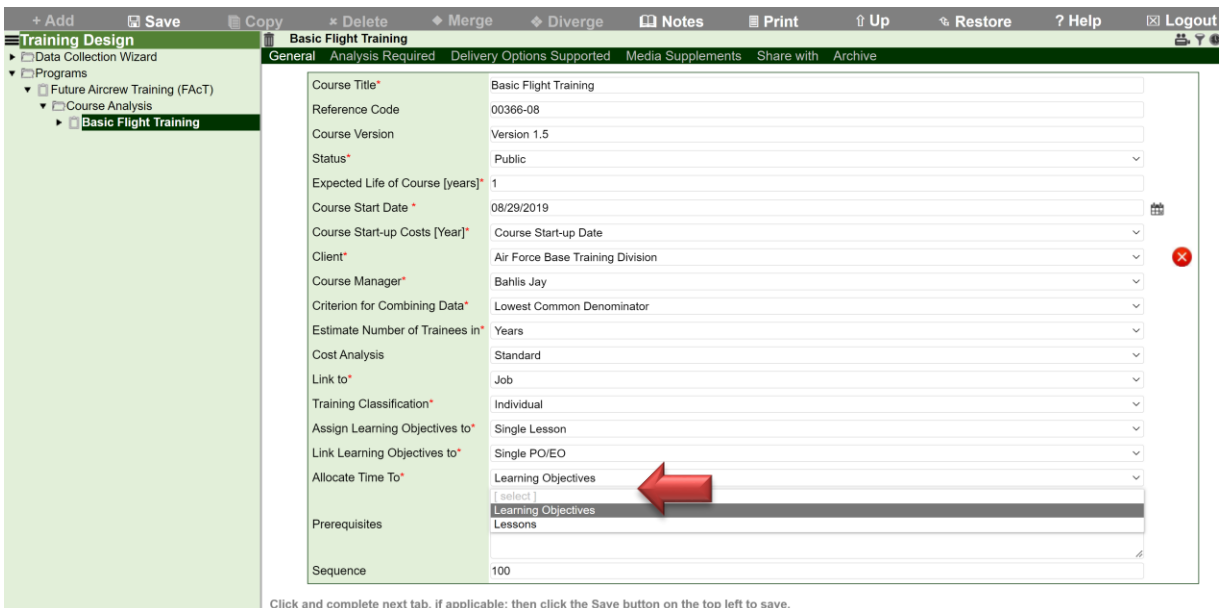

Enhanced Security: SAML Idp Initiated Single Sign On

Support SAML Idp Initiated Single Sign On in addition to Lightweight Directory Access Protocol (LDAP) and Site Minder Single Sign On. With the SAML option, users can no longer log directly into ADVISOR. To log into ADVISOR, users will have to click on a tile (icon) created by the IT department. By clicking on the tile (icon), users redirects users to ADVISOR, verifies their credentials and automatically logs-in users with an ADVISOR account.
